



Ernie Banks “Mr. Cub”

Ernie Banks played for the Chicago Cubs from 1953 to 1971 and was elected into the Major League Baseball Hall of Fame. During his career he hit 512 home runs, was an 11-time All-Star and won Baseball’s Most Valuable Player Award twice. His number has been retired by the Chicago Cubs and is proudly displayed at all Cub games. In 2008, a statue of Ernie was dedicated and is displayed outside of Wrigley Field.
